3. Graph Paper/ Dry Erase Marker



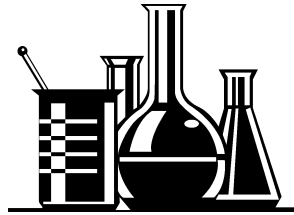
ELA

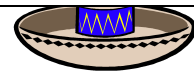
